


ReStores are home improvement outlets that accept donations and sell new and gently used products for your home and garden, and offer tremendous benefits to shoppers, donors and community alike.


Southern Alberta is home to three ReStores, with two located in Calgary and a third in Medicine Hat. These ReStores benefit households and businesses in the community by creating a sustainable environment while simultaneously supporting Habitat for Humanity's affordable housing initiatives.

Businesses and households benefit by having a place to donate their new or gently-used furniture, appliances, building materials, home decor, and more, knowing that it's supporting a community cause.

The ReStores are an important funding source for Habitat. Proceeds from the ReStores are put towards administration costs, allowing donations to Habitat to go directly towards our construction and affordable home ownership programs.







business benefits

3 ways ReStores provide solutions for the business community

1. Improve operations and reduce costs

for many companies, old or unusable inventory takes up valuable space, occupying areas that could be used to store revenue-generating inventory.

Donating to the ReStore allows businesses to create space and tidy up surplus or unusable inventory. A regular cycle of donating can even reduce the need for storage space.

Plus, when you donate to the ReStore, you avoid transportation and dumping fees at a landfill, which allows you to cut costs and boost your bottom line.

2. Receive a charitable tax receipt

Some businesses are able to write off material they are removing from inventory, but many businesses can benefit from receiving a charitable tax receipt for the value of their donation instead.

In accordance with CRA regulations, the value of the tax receipt is determined by the ReStore, and is based on how much the ReStore can sell the donation for on the sales floor.

3. Be a good corporate citizen

Many businesses make a commitment to Corporate Social Responsibility and produce reports for their stakeholders and shareholders. Others simply do good to seek a general social license and appropriation in the community. For some, it's about pure philanthropy and giving back.

Whatever the reason, donating to the ReStore offers your community several types of community impact to share with your stakeholders, which is something you can feel good about.

- 4,653 donations made to the Southern Alberta ReStores
- **\$4,151,000** total value of donations
- 70% of the value of donations came from the business community
- 2,400 tonnes of product were saved from entering landfills
- \$1 million contributed to Habitat for Humanity Southern Alberta
