

## Safety Program Consultant

Are you a senior leader in workplace safety? Do you have experience developing best-practice safety programs for multiple industries and sectors?

Habitat for Humanity Southern Alberta is seeking an experienced senior consultant to lead a project to build upon our existing workplace safety program and achieve the next level of performance. We are seeking someone to develop a comprehensive and integrated safety program that develops policies, processes and practices which will keep our staff safe, improve safety performance and fully address regulatory requirements, for our unique workplace context.

Habitat has four different workplaces that require a safety focus:

- Trucking, warehousing and retail: Our three ReStores comprise a program in which \$4 million of appliances, furniture, home improvement and home renovation products are donated by businesses and homeowners; picked up by trucking staff; received, warehoused and displayed in large retail facilities for sale to the public; utilizing a mix of paid staff and volunteers.
- Home construction sites: Each year, we build 20 or more new starter homes in Southern Alberta utilizing a mix of staff professionals, contractors and volunteers. Habitat also hosts fundraising and engagement events on these sites.
- Head office: Our head office contains 25 full-time staff and between 1 and 4 volunteers weekly.
- Special event locations: As part of fundraising and community engagement, we are involved in bike rides, golf tournaments, and other community events.

Habitat is seeking a consultant with broad experience at a senior level in workplace safety, who would be able to dedicate significant time to an assignment of three to nine months. Our goal is to build a safety program that can be maintained, managed and administered by our full-time safety advisor (in recruitment).
