

## Habitat for Humanity Calgary Worker Rules

- All workers must be present for each day's Safety Talk. If you are late arriving, please check in with a Habitat staff member to update yourself on the day's safety concerns.
  - •We strive to respect your time while you are here; we appreciate your efforts to be respectful of others' time by being punctual.
- Please be respectful of others at all times. Verbal abuse, inappropriate speech and inappropriate behaviour will not be tolerated.
  - •We have a **zero tolerance policy regarding verbal, physical, and sexual harassment**. Please contact a Habitat staff member or the Volunteer Manager if you have any questions or concerns. Inappropriate behaviour may result in your being asked to leave.
- Fighting, horseplay and practical jokes may pose unintended and dangerous consequences.
  - •Please refrain from such actions.
- Theft and Vandalism are illegal. Please remember that we are a Not-for-Profit Family Charity. We hope that is enough of a reason its own to prevent such actions.
  - •We need what we have and what we have has come from generous donations from hard-working people just like you!
- The use or possession of alcohol or illicit drugs on Habitat for Humanity property is strictly prohibited.
- Smoking is prohibited on Habitat for Humanity property except in designated areas.
