

Habitat for Humanity Southern Alberta (Habitat) 50/50 Raffle Fundraiser

March 2020

Rules and Regulations License #559502

1. **Date and Location of Draw:** On April 3, 2020 at 12:00 pm the winning ticket will be drawn at Habitat for Humanity Southern Alberta office located at Suite 210, 805 Manning Road NE, Calgary, AB.
2. **Eligibility:** Ticket purchasers must be 18 years of age or older. Employees of Habitat and members of their immediate family (defined as mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter, husband or wife) are not eligible to participate (purchase tickets or receive the prize) in the 50/50 raffle.
3. **Minor Children:** AGLC advises that adult ticket purchasers not write a name of person under 18 years of age on the ticket.
4. **Tickets:**
 - a. Tickets are available and sold in the following quantities:
 - i. 1 for \$10 (500 tickets printed)
 - ii. 5 for \$20 (2550 tickets printed)
 - iii. 20 for \$50 (1920 tickets printed)
 - b. Tickets will be sold on-line from March 1, 2020 to March 31, 2020 at <https://www.rafflebox.ca/raffle/habitat> and in person at the following locations and dates:
 - i. Every Thursday, Friday and Saturday during the month of March from 11:00 am – 2:00 pm at both Calgary ReStore locations (3465 Sunridge Way NE, Calgary AB and 7291 11th Street SE, Calgary AB).
 - ii. March 9, 10, 11 each day from 11:00 am – 2:00 pm in the TC Energy Tower (450, 1st Street SW, Calgary AB) Plus 15 level beside Sunterra Market.
 - iii. March 16 through March 20, and March 23 through March 27 each day from 11:00 am – 2:00 pm at The Core shopping centre (333 7th Avenue SW) in the Guest Services booth.
 - iv. March 13 from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm, March 14 from 11:00 am – 2:00 pm, March 27 from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm, and March 28 from 11:00 am – 2:00 pm at CrossIron Mills shopping centre (261055 CrossIron Blvd, Rocky View AB) in the Community Kiosk near Guest Services.
5. **Ticket Refunds:** To request a ticket refund please contact Habitat at info@habitatsouthernab.ca. Refunds will be offered on a case-by-case basis
6. **The Draw:** A ticket stub containing the ticket serial number of each sold ticket shall be placed in a draw container. The draw will take place at Habitat office on April 3, 2020 at 12:00 pm. The draws is open to the public.

The Draw shall be conducted as follows:

 - a. One ticket will be manually drawn at random (the “Draw”) to win the Prize;
 - b. At least two members of Habitat paid staff will be present to witness the draw

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- c. The Draw can be made by any person who does not own a ticket or a share of a ticket in the Draw;
 - d. The arm of the person making the Draw must be “bare” of clothing below the elbow, he/she must exhibit his/her Draw arm and both sides of his/her open hand to the Draw witnesses immediately prior to making the Draw;
 - e. Only the person making the Draw may put their arm/hand in the Draw container. When selecting a ticket to be the winning ticket, the person making the Draw shall look away from the container;
 - f. Selected tickets shall be immediately exhibited to the Draw witnesses and held open for inspection.
7. **The Prize:** The raffle prize will be 50% of the gross revenue from all tickets sold. A minimum \$4000 prize will be awarded to the prize winner; the maximum prize amount is \$10,000.
- a. Chances of winning is dependent on the number of tickets sold.
 - b. A maximum of 4970 tickets are printed and can be sold under this license.
8. **Winner Notification:**
- a. The winning ticket number will be published on www.habitatsouthernab.ca;
 - b. The prize winner will be notified via phone and email and have 30 days to claim the prize;
 - c. In the event the winner cannot be reached and/or does not claim their prize in 30 days, an alternate prize winner will be drawn by and notified by phone and email and will have 30 days to claim the prize.
 - d. The prize will be awarded by cheque which can be picked up at the HFHSA office or mailed to the winner at their discretion.
9. **Use of Proceeds:** all proceeds (after expenses) will be used towards a Habitat build project in Calgary, Alberta Canada.
10. **Legislation:** The raffle is conducted and managed completely in the province of Alberta and is compliant with AGLC rules. All ticket will be sold within the province of Alberta.
